Health and Social Care is a generic term which relates to services that are available from health and social care providers in the UK. These providers are from both the public and private sector. Health care provides both preventive and reactive clinical treatment for ill health and medical conditions.



<u>Health care</u> is primarily provided in hospitals, health centres and clinics and within the community. If you work in health care, you could care for people in hospitals, clinics, medical centres and in the individual's own home.



<u>Social care</u> is the provision of non-clinical physical, emotional and social care and support of vulnerable people. Can you think of nay examples?




