What should I do to revise and prepare for this assessment?

To prepare for this assessment:

Reading and listening

1. Use your 'livret de vocabulaire' to revise vocabulary from all units, using the look, cover, write, check method to make sure you know what the words and phrases mean in English.
2. Use This is Language to practise listening exercises.
3. Use Kerboodle to practise reading and listening exercises from the online text books.

Writing

1. Revise the vocabulary and phrases from the unit knowledge organisers (1-7) using the look, cover, write, check method to make sure you can write the phrases in French.
2. Revise the 44 fantastic phrases (foundation)/75 fantastic phrases (higher) from the unit 1 knowledge organiser.
3. Use the 'livret de grammaire' and verb tables to practise forming and writing verbs in three tenses.
4. Use the PowerPoints on Show My Homework to revise what you need to include in your answers.
