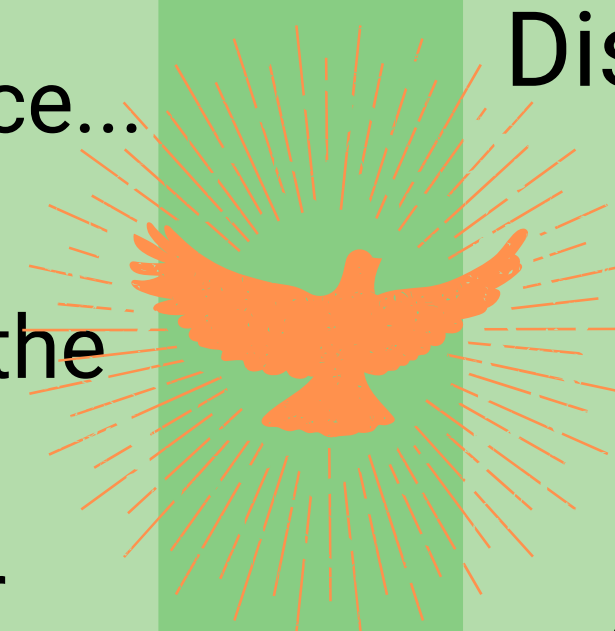
Holy Spirit, may I be made aware of your presence...
