Reading and listening

- Understanding phrases and vocabulary when I hear them and responding to questions about what I have heard.
- Understanding phrases and vocabulary when I see them written down and responding to questions about what I have read.
- Translating text from French to English.
- Transcribing short sentences.

Foundation Writing

- Writing 5 sentences to describe a photo.
- Writing a 50 word response which addresses 5 bullet points.
- Completing 5 short grammar tasks.
- Translating sentences from English to French.
- Writing a 90 word response which addresses 3 bullet points, using 3 tenses.

Higher Writing

- Translating sentences from English to French.
- Writing a 90 word response which addresses 3 bullet points, using 3 tenses.
- Writing a 150 word response which addresses 2 bullet points, using at least 2 tenses.



What should I do to revise and prepare for this assessment?

To prepare for this assessment:

Reading and listening

- 1. Use your knowledge organisers to revise vocabulary from units 1 and unit 2, using the look, cover, write, check method to make sure you know what the words and phrases mean in English.
- 2. Use Kerboodle to practise reading and listening exercises.
- 3. Use Language Nut to practise vocabulary, reading, listening and grammar exercises.

Writing

- 1. Revise the vocabulary and phrases from the unit 1 and unit 2 knowledge organisers using the look, cover, write, check method to make sure you can write the phrases in French.
- 2. Revise the 44 fantastic phrases (foundation)/75 fantastic phrases (higher) from the unit 1 knowledge organiser (they are also in the unit 2 knowledge organiser).
- 3. Use the 'livret de grammaire' to revise how to form verbs in three tenses.
