- 3) The different theoretical approaches to stratification including the feminist, functionalist, Marxist and Weber.
- 4) The different methods that can be used to study human behaviour.
- 5) The strengths and weaknesses of these methods, including the practical, ethical and theoretical issues.

What should I do to revise and prepare for this assessment?

To prepare for this assessment:

1. Use the knowledge organisers to remind yourself of the key definitions.
2. Review the sociologists and their perspective on stratification.
3. Be aware of the biomedical and social model of disability.
4. Look at how a person's ethnicity can impact on their health, education, crime, work and stereotypes in the media.
5. Review the strengths and weaknesses of all research methods; interviews (group, structured, unstructured), observations (participant, non-participant, covert and overt), secondary data (statistics, diaries, documents), questionnaires
