Creating an appropriate visual style for presentation. This includes:

- ☐ The font style for the headings/ titles of each section of your work
- ☐ The font style for the main text / research you have on each page
- ☐ Using images related to your topic to create a background that reinforces/ communicates what your specific topic is about
- ☐ You need to know how to use the different tools on Photoshop, Photopea and power-point, for example, how to edit and manipulate images using the adjustment and filter tools.

What should I do to revise and prepare for this assessment?



To prepare for this assessment:

You are expected to produce a significant amount of contextual research about your chosen NEA (coursework) theme. You must have completed at least 10 double pages by the end of the exam. This includes all work you have completed to date and your mind map.

You must complete the work schedule sheet and agree with Mrs Frost the work you will carry out during the exam days.

You need to continue to gather and take photographs which you can professionally print and then present in your NEA A2 sketchbook. These provide the essential primary source material from which you are required to work.

As communicated over the past 3 weeks, much of this preparation must be done over this half term.

What useful websites/resources could I use to help me prepare?

The website you can use are vast and very specific to the focus and context of your research. Please check the validity of your sources, for example, web addresses ending in .GOV or .ORG are credible as they must comply with strict laws about the factual accuracy of information published.
