What key topics do I need to know and remember...

Paper 1: Understanding social processes

Social Processes

- Students should be able to recall sociological terms such as culture, norms, values, roles, status, identity, sanctions, cultural diversity.
- They should understand the term role model, formal and informal social control, the nature and nurture debate.

Family

- Students must understand the different theoretical perspectives on the family
- Students must understand the term conjugal roles, including segregated and joint
- Students must understand the term child-centered society and the reasons for this.

Education

- Students must understand the different theoretical approaches to education including Marxism, functionalism and feminism.

Research Methods

- Students must understand the different sociological terms such as reliability, ethical issues, representativeness, validity and objectivity.
- Students must be able to apply their knowledge of research methods to a scenario
- Students must understand the strengths and weaknesses of different methods such as Official statistics, different types of observation and questionnaires.
