Reading and listening

- Understanding phrases and vocabulary when I hear them and responding to questions about what I have heard.
- Understanding phrases and vocabulary when I see them written down and responding to questions about what I have read.
- Translating text from Spanish to English.
- Transcribing short sentences.

Writing

- Translating sentences from English to Spanish.
- Writing a 90 word response which addresses 3 bullet points, using 3 tenses.
- Writing a 150 word response which addresses 2 bullet points, using at least 2 tenses.

Speaking

- Answering the general conversation questions (without using notes)

To prepare for this assessment:

Reading and listening

1. Use your knowledge organisers to revise vocabulary, using the look, cover, write, check method to make sure you know what the words and phrases mean in English.
2. Use Kerboodle to practise reading and listening exercises.
3. Use Language Nut to practise vocabulary, reading, listening and grammar exercises.

Writing

1. Revise the vocabulary and phrases from the knowledge organisers using the look, cover, write, check method to make sure you can write the phrases in Spanish.
2. Revise the fantastic phrases.
3. Revise how to form verbs in three tenses.

Speaking

1. Revise your speaking answers.
